Students from these countries who have completed a minimum of two years of secondary education in their home country and who have earned a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale are exempt from the English language requirement. Students from countries who do not submit an ACT or SAT score must submit an ACT or SAT score to the campus of their choice.
