UCA's Academic Integrity Policy – Board of Trustees Policy No.

– was developed by faculty, students, and administrators over a period of several years. It rea rms the university's commitment to academic integrity, provides for consequences when academic integrity is violated, and de nes due process rights for those who are alleged to have violated academic integrity. e new policy was adopted by the UCA Board of Trustees to become e ective in the fall semester

KEY PROVISIONS

Four key elements characterize the Academic Integrity Policy:

- 1. e policy identi es a positive context ("academic integrity") for integrity violations.
- e policy creates a formal mechanism for o cial allegations of academic dishonesty / misconduct in the context of an academic course.
- 3. e policy mandates that o cially alleged violations of academic integrity in the context of an academic course become a part of the permanent student record.
- 4. e policy de nes an appeals process with signicant participation by faculty, sta, and students.
