INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

In order to be considered as an applicant in the UCA DPT professional program international students must:

achieve a minimum score of **600** on the **TOEFL**;

provide an analysis of all international courses completed in the past to include:

- o number of semester credit hours for each class
- o grade for *each class*
- o courses offered at UCA with which <u>each class</u> is equivalent;

Please note that World Education Services (WES) is the preferred foreign transcript evaluation service for PTCAS applicants with non-US coursework. Only WES will be accepted beginning with the 2014-2015 application cycle.

an overall GPA submitted by the company analyzing the previous coursework is not sufficient. *Each course* must be analyzed.

submit UCA Application for International Admission including:

- o a \$50 application fee
- o copy of government issued identification
- o academic records
- TOEFL score
- o proof of financial support for one academic year of tuition (approximately \$31,000)
