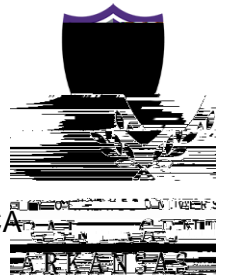


University Scholarship Policy 2020-2021 Academic Scholarship Policy

This policy covers the Future Leader (2-years) University, Achievement, Excellence, and Presidential Distinguished Scholarships.

Eligibility:

- x To be eligible for scholarship consideration, students must:
 - o Submit required documentation to the Office of Admissions and Enrollment Services by December 10, 2019;
 - o Be a first-time entering undergraduate;
 - o Have a minimum ACT superscore of 23 or the SAT equivalent. Qualifying scores must be on a test within the last five years and no later than November 2019
 - o Have completed all remediation requirements;
 - o Meet GPA Requirements:
 - Future Leaders, University, and Achievement Scholarships
 - x Minimum 3.25 cumulative high school GPA (on a 4.00 GPA scale)



- o Year two and after (Fall to Spring)
Earn a minimum of 12 UCA undergraduate credit hours with a minimum 3.00 (University) or 3.25 (Achievement) cumulative undergraduate GPA
- o Year two and after (Spring to Fall)
Earn a minimum of 30 UCA undergraduate credit hours (Fall/Spring combined) with a minimum 3.00 (University) or 3.25 (Achievement) cumulative undergraduate GPA
- x If requirements have been completed at the end of the Spring semester, the scholarship will renew at that time.
- x If requirements are not completed at the end of the Spring semester, the UCA summer term hours and GPA will be considered in the renewal process.
- x Academic performance will be evaluated at the end of the Summer I term for students who do not meet requirements after the Spring semester. If requirements are completed at the end of the Summer I term, the scholarship will renew at that time.
