



- ” To be eligible for scholarship consideration, students must:
 - o Be named a Bear Partner scholarship student at a participating 2-year college;
 - o Be an incoming full-time, first-year student at a participating 2-year college;

- ” Student must be enrolled in a minimum of 15 UCA undergraduate credit hours as of the 8th class day each semester during the term of their scholarship.
- ” Scholarships are for the duration of four consecutive semesters or through the completion of a degree program.
- ” Student must maintain good academic standing as defined by the current Undergraduate Bulletin.
- ” The scholarship is awarded for the Fall and Spring semesters only.

- ” To renew the scholarship, students must:
 - o Complete the requirements for the scholarship
Earn a minimum of 12 UCA undergraduate credit hours with a minimum 3.25 UCA cumulative undergraduate GPA.
 - o Complete the requirements for the scholarship
Earn a minimum of 30 UCA undergraduate credit hours (Fall/Spring combined) with a minimum 3.25 UCA cumulative undergraduate GPA. If requirements have been completed, the scholarship will renew to the next semester.
 - o Complete the requirements for the scholarship
Earn a minimum of 15 UCA undergraduate credit hours with a minimum 3.25 UCA cumulative undergraduate GPA. If requirements have been completed, the scholarship will renew to the next semester.
- ” If requirements are not completed at the end of the Spring semester then UCA summer term hours and GPA will be considered in the renewal process.
- ” Academic performance will be evaluated at the end of the Summer I term for students who do not meet requirements after the Spring semester. If requirements have been completed at the end of

- ” There will be no reinstatement of a lost scholarship.
- ” Costs associated with Summer Courses are not covered by Bear Partner scholarships.
- ” The hours and grades/credits associated with Graduate, Department of Student Transitions, and Intensive English Program courses are not considered in renewal or disbursement of Bear Partner scholarships.
- ” Students can receive only one of the following awards: Academic All-Star Scholarship, Bear Partner Scholarship, or Transfer Scholarship.
- ” Bear Partner scholarships will only apply to charges for in-state tuition and mandatory fees directly assessed by the University except for approved programs through the Office of Study Abroad. For such programs, the scholarship may be applied only to actual tuition and mandatory fees assessed.
