

Eligibility:

To be eligible for scholarship consideration, students must:

- o Submit required documentation to the Office of Admissions and Enrollment Services by the scholarship deadlines listed below;
- o Be an incoming full-time, first-
Have been enrolled at an accredited college/university. Have completed

all remediation requirements; and,

- o Be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen.

To assist in determining whether remediation requirements have been satisfied, students are encouraged to submit test scores (e.g., ACT, SAT, AP, CLEP).

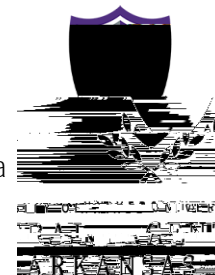
Credit hours earned and cumulative GPA for scholarship consideration will be based only on courses completed per official transcripts on file as of the scholarship deadline.

Award Requirements:

Students must be enrolled in a minimum of 15 UCA undergraduate credit hours as of the 8th class day each semester during the term of their scholarship.

Scholarships are for the duration of four consecutive semesters or through the completion of a bachelor's degree, whichever occurs first.

Students must maintain good academic standing as defined by the current Undergraduate Bulletin during the term of their scholarship.

Earn a minimum of 30 UCA undergraduate credit hours (Fall/Spring combined) with a minimum 3.25 UCA cumulative undergraduate GPA. If requirements have been completed, the scholarship will renew to the next semester.

Earn a minimum of 15 UCA undergraduate credit hours with a minimum 3.25 UCA cumulative undergraduate GPA. If requirements have been completed, the scholarship will renew to the next semester.

If requirements have been completed at the end of the Spring semester, the scholarship will renew at that time.
