Additional Freshman Academic Scholarship Information



Required documentation must be submitted to the Office of Admissions and Enrollment Services by the applicable deadline.

If a student is graduating from high school early, a 4th or 5th semester transcript will be considered.

All institutional scholarships are highly competitive and awarded based on academic performance and available funds.

Scholarships are for the duration of 8 consecutive fall and spring semesters or through completion of a bachelor's degree, whichever occurs first.

Students must be enrolled in a minimum of 15 UCA credit hours as of the 8th class day each fall and spring semester during the term of their scholarship.

Students must remain in good academic standing as described in the <u>current UCA Undergraduate Bulletin</u>.

Students must live in University housing to receive the housing award and therefore the annual total award. Click <u>here</u> to learn more about University housing options.

Academic scholarships will only apply to charges for in-state tuition, room/board, and mandatory fees directly assessed by the University. The housing award will only apply to housing charges directly assessed by the University.
