



University Scholarship Policy
Scholarship Eligibility Based on Citizenship
Last Revision: 01/2024

To be eligible for university academic scholarships, a student must be classified as either a:

1. United States citizen,
2. Permanent resident of the United States,
3. Refugee, or
4. Asylum Grantee.

International students who do not hold any of the above classifications are eligible to apply for and be awarded scholarships through the Center for Global Learning and Engagement, as well as through a variety of additional scholarships generally defined in the General Statement and listed on the Scholarship Designation Listing. Requirements may differ for each type of scholarship and it is the student
