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1. General

The Board of Trustees of the Universityt,

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2. General Standards of Conduct

- a. A trustee shall discharge hise/r duties as a member of the board in otherall best interests of the niversity. In performing his/her duties, a trustee should always act in good faith and with the care an ordinarily prudent person in the same or similar position would exercise under similar circustances.
- b. In making decisions, a trustee is entitled to rely on information, opinions, reports, or statements including financial statements and other financial data, prepared or presented by:
 - Officers or employees of theniwersity whom the trstee reasonably believes to be reliable and competent in the matters presented;

- ii. Legal counsel, public accountants, the Arkansas Attorney General, or other persons as to matters that the trustee reasonably believes are within the 'person professional, official or expert competence.
- c. A trustee is not acting in good faith if the trustee has knowledge concerning the matter in question that makes reliance otherwise permitted by subsection (ha) ranted.

3. Conflicts of Interest

- a. A "conflict of interest transaction" is a transaction with the ersity in which a trustee has a direct or indirect interest.
- b. A trustee has a direct interest in a transaction, if the trustee, or a member of the trustee immediate family, will derive an economic benefit. A trustee main direct interest in a transaction if (i) another entity in which the trustee has a material interest or in which

- a. Members of the boardshall annually submit a statement to the osterary of the board on or before January 31 of each year, disclosing whether the trustee, his or her immediate family member, or any entity in which he or she holds any position of control or holds any ownershipinterest of 10% or greater, has entitle into any contract with the university or whether an immediate family member of the trustee is employed by the university.
- b. For purposes of this policy, "contract" shall mean any agreement entered into by and betweenthe university and a trustee or entity in which he or she holds any position of control or holds any ownership interest of 10% greater pursuant to which the university agrees to purchase or lease tangible personal property, real property, or services, pany agreement for the disposal of commodities and services, including, but not limited to, awards and notices of awards, contracts of a fixed price, cost, or incentive type, contracts providing for the issuance of job or task orders, leases, leases purcha agreements, letter contracts, purchase orders, professional or consultant services contracts, and supplemental agreements with respect to any of these categories. Contracts shall also include grants. Further, for purposes of this policy, "immediate family member" shall mean a trusteespouse, children of the trustee or hes/spouse. brothers. or reats the trustees hhise/r and sisters. of spouse.
- c. As a part of such annual disclosure, each trustee shall acknow, butaJolac eae olonty ow
